

# LONGABERGER BASKET® BOTTOMS

## FEATURES:

- Solid wood bottoms are made from a variety of hardwoods and can be sculpted into ornate shapes due to their thickness.
- Board bottoms are made from hardwood plywoods.
- Kerf bottoms have a groove slotted on the side that holds weaves in place and do not require tacks.
- Open weave and reinforced bottoms allow for functionality, stability and air flow.

## BENEFITS:

- Reinforcements and boards create stability and strength.
- Both solid wood and board bottom baskets allow for the basket to rest on flat surfaces.

## CARE:

- For solid woods and board bottoms, use mild soap and water to gently clean. Dry with a clean cloth.
- Kerf bottoms that are finished with a WoodCrafts finish should be cleaned with furniture polish, spraying the polish on the cloth, not directly on the kerf bottom.

## GOOD THINGS TO KNOW:

- Board bottoms should come with felt feet (available through Supply Order or at any home improvement store) to help protect surfaces that may be scratched due to exposed tack heads.
