CARE

- Clean using furniture polish applied to a soft cloth.
- Warm water and mild soap can also be used if immediately wiped dry.
- Avoid direct sunlight to reduce fading.
- Engraved and heat transfer lids can be cleansed using the same methods as regular lids. Lids with decorative inserts (like metal or ceramic) may require another method, depending on the material used.
- Do not place shelves over an air vent.

GOOD THINGS TO KNOW

- Use of red maple, a softer grade of maple, is used occasionally.
- Lids are made to fit the averages of baskets, allowing for variances.
- Lids utilize wood to its fullest, providing a wide range of color and markings.
- Heat transfers are applied using heat and pressure. The heat actually infuses the transfer onto the finish, making it very durable.
- Engraved lids will vary in depth and darkness, depending on the density of the wood fibers.
